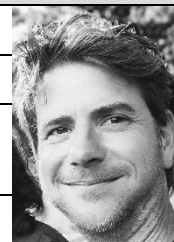

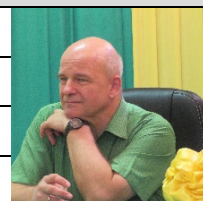

<p>Rice production in the South-Kivu province in the Democratic Republic of Congo does not meet local demand despite its enormous production potential. Sustainable increase in rice production requires efficient and environmentally-sound management practices and a baseline assessment of current agronomic practices. The main objective of this project is to assess the effect of nutrient management via biochar amendment on paddy rice yield and soil properties, by using and demonstrating the potential of unmanned aerial vehicle (UAV) imaging technology in precision agriculture. Experimental plots have been installed in the lowlands of the Ruzizi plain, particularly in Lubarika, Luberizi and Kiringye, applying different</p>	

types of biochar (0 t ha^{-1} ; 5 t ha^{-1} soil biochar and 5 t ha^{-1} charged biochar) under alternating wetting and drying (AWD) water management regimes and considering two rice varieties (one which is commonly used by farmers and the second one which is being introduced by the ministry of agriculture in the region). Biochar was locally produced using homemade pyrolysis reactors and applied only once, two weeks before the installation of the first season experiment. Mineral fertilizers NPK (102-25-51) were applied during the three seasons of the study. Perforated PVC pipes (30 cm diameter, 40 cm long) were installed in the center of the sub-plots where AWD was applied to measure water depth and define the application and removal of water. Vegetative parameters considered in the study include: the number of tillers, the plant height, the leaf area, plant root biomass. As for yield parameters, the number of panicles, the grain and biomass yield as well as the grain harvest index were considered. The rice crop response to different management practices has been established through imaging using UAV spectroscopy approaches with a multispectral (visible-infrared) camera. Two flights were planned and executed in each site during the two first seasons. After each flight, destructive plant samples were collected, dried. The samples will be analyzed at the lab and used as 'ground truth' measurements to calibrate image-based analyses. In order to assess the impact of management practices to soil physico-chemical properties, soil samples were collected in each plot before installing the experiment and after the harvest of the last season. Through this study, we will establish how different management practices influence rice phenology and yield along the cropping seasons, how different types of biochar and their residual effects affect soil physico-chemical. Through UAV-imaging, the influence of biochar amendments on rice N-uptake will also be assessed. This study is of great importance in the South-Kivu province where the demand for rice keeps increasing but where limited studies have been conducted to improve sustainable paddy rice production. The applied study will therefore contribute to hunger and poverty reduction in the region and facilitate cross-border collaboration and capacity building in Sub-Saharan Africa—using a timely, digital approach to facilitate advanced agronomic techniques.

Title: Establishing a research chair on forced internal displacement at Bahir Dar University in Ethiopia

Ethiopia has one of the world's largest internally displaced persons (IDPs) that reached 3.5 million in 2019 and continuing to rise sharply. The primary reasons include violence due to ethnic conflicts, economic grievance, political instability, and climate change shocks. This project will focus on five priority areas to document the challenges IDPs face and generate evidence to inform policy by establishing a research chair at Bahir Dar University in Ethiopia: 1) education and health, 2) governance, 3) climate change, 4) disaster risk management, and 5) inclusive economies. The overarching goal is to strengthen the resilience of IDPs through education, research, and inform policymakers to establish and enhance livelihood strategies that provide a decent life to IDPs. The specific objectives are to i) enhance the capacity of the chair holder's institute in education and research related to IDPs, ii) generate evidence-based policy influence and iii) enhance the economic and social demands of IDPs. The first objective will be addressed by establishing two postgraduate programs at Bahir Dar University: Masters in disaster risk management and food systems resilience in protracted crises, and PhD enforced displacement and migration. There will be collaboration with University of Masinde Muliro University in Kenya. Both countries share borders with Ethiopia and showed an increase in IDPs. The second objective will be achieved through primary research findings and evidence synthesis. Enhancement of livelihoods of IDPs and integration with host communities, strengthening existing structure of stakeholders, and establishing volunteer platforms to create a sustainable community of practice beyond the IDRC funding cycle will address the third objective. Achieving the national, regional and IDRC's strategic priorities through gender equality and inclusion, evidence-based policies, creating decent livelihoods, and improved services will have a significant impact on the physical and mental health of IDPs in Ethiopia and the region

Food security is an issue of great and growing concern in many countries especially now, as the **food security situation is bound to deteriorate** due the current war in Ukraine and it effects on global food triage in particularly in Africa. Feeding over 6 billion people – and over 9 billion by 2050 worldwide – will require a wide range of creative, sustainable agricultural systems which not only provide food, but also factor in the economic value of nature-based services such as forests and soil organisms underpinning agriculture. The establishment of **Organic food systems (OAFS) and Organic agriculture (OA)** especially for small scaled producers **positively contributes to food security** while promoting ecologically sound strategies and practices among diverse stakeholders in production, processing, marketing, and policymaking to safeguard the environment, improve livelihoods and alleviate poverty. Nevertheless, there is still a **tremendous lack of awareness resp. willingness in governmental institutions** in Ethiopia and Uganda on this matter resulting in diminutive concrete supportive action for it. SOFOS is therefor designed to strengthen the Organic Food Systems through capacity building in higher Education, research and community outreach in OA at **Bahir Dar University (BDU)**, Ethiopia and **St. Lawrence University (SLAU)**, Uganda. The aim of SOFOS broadly is guided by three expected outcomes:

1) Improved and more practical quality education in OA by the introduction of the Master in Science in Organic Agriculture and Food Systems (MSc in OAFS) based on a new philosophy of teaching based on case study learning and the ideas of *Greenpedagogy* and the significant involvement of Multistakeholder's platform (MSP) to improve food self-sufficiency and access to OA markets;

2) Strengthened capacities in the implementation of quality participatory Action Research (PAR) to reduce the distance from academia to real life challenges of involved stakeholders and

3) Increasing the capacity of BDU and SLAU in OA outreach to give the farmers the opportunity to actively participate in the development and consequently the adoption of OA by establishing an Organic agriculture Outreach Centre (OAO) both at BDU and SLAU for training of staff, students and stakeholders and PAR and Organic Agriculture Lead Farms (OALF) in the Farmer Family Learning Groups (FFLG) with Organic lead farmers serving as the Community Based Facilitators (CBF) enabling learning and research innovations through Living Labs, circular-solidarity economy approach and local market linkages. Accordingly, SOFOS' focus is on elaborating, monitoring, evaluating and optimizing the practical MSc in OAFS program and enhancing stakeholder participation and feedback as well as analysis.

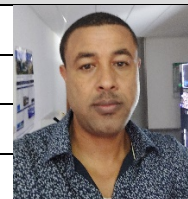
The **coordination institution of the SOFOS project is BDU** with experiences in several OA research activities and a single course on OA. However, a comprehensive teaching and research program for OAFS is however missing. **SLAU, participates** due to existing OA course in BSc programs in environmental studies, knowledge in IT and entrepreneurship in OA as well as strong demand and local market development of OA in Uganda.

SOFOS primarily addresses the capacity-building needs of southern partner institutes through tailored training, especially in the fields of OA, pedagogy and curriculum development and PAR to improve teaching-learning methods of for the MSc in OAFS that qualifies students interacting to real life challenges of involved stakeholders and positively influence the development of the Organic sector in the respective country. This is directly in line with the EU objective of strengthening institutional capacities in higher education and research for development. Many features of SOFOS are innovative in the given settings:

- The participatory curriculum development process including the MSP;
- the use of OAO and OALFs as the sides for practicing new pedagogical approaches (mutual learning) and establish trials and PAR;
- the case study learning approach in each module and the placing of students to the FFLGs to make both the students and the trained CBFs to agents of change;
- the incorporation of an extended internship component for MSc students to enforce OA in the respective countries;
- The strengthening of OA teaching infrastructure by integration of ICT in extension through the use of digital classrooms and many more.

All scheduled activities have adequate involvement of vulnerable communities and stakeholders at all levels. The establishment of the MSP, building inclusivesocieties and promoting women, the Advancement of young / particularly female researchers, and Collaborative Smartphone applications for agricultural management are some of the added value of the project.

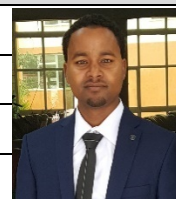

<p>Food insecurity and malnutrition coupled with pollution of surface water resources with untreated industrial wastewater partly from traditionally implemented aquaculture system are major global issues. The proposed project thus, aims to develop pilot-scale aquaponics systems in three (3) selected Districts in Eastern Uganda. Aquaponics principle couples aquaculture (especially fish farming) with hydroponic (vegetables) production for saving resources. The objectives will be to: Design, construct and operate pilot-scale aquaponics system in model districts; ii) train selected clusters of women and youth in the communities about culturing fish in combination with vegetables and iii) train women and youth on how to fabricate and establish Aquaponics systems employing locally available materials. Although quite little studied especially in rural settings in the developing countries, aquaponics have added advantages over aquaculture in that it maximizes the benefits and eliminates the limitations of independent operation of either as aquaculture or hydroponic systems including: i) the system saves water due to recirculation; ii) can be replicated for nutritional cultivation of fish and a variety of vegetables for commercial application as well as backyard gardening for elevated food security and iii) the wastewater discharged from fish culture facilities are the sources of the plants' nutrients hence minimal or zero waste discharge among others. To address the high costs due to the high energy demand during recirculation of water, given that Ingrid energy is erratic in Uganda, the aquaponics system will be designed to use solar energy. The pilot-scale project will act as a basis to upscale to an "aquaponic demonstration and training centers" for local fish farmers, students and other community members in the selected district.</p>

For many years, it has been believed that the shortage of land is the main issue limiting agriculture production. Besides, it is well that Kigezi is overpopulated and that, in the absence of intervention, it will suffer severe environmental harm to the grave disadvantage of its population in western Uganda. During colonial times, the farms were well organized, with well-maintained terraces. To date, the area is facing the problem of water deficit and bare terrains. These factors have led to a shortage of agricultural land and poor pasture conditions.</p> <p>Due to a shortage of agricultural land, Kigezi highlands are continuously and haphazardly farmed. Under intense strain, the fertile layer of the ground is deteriorating and eroding. Plant biomass and crop yields are declining. Even without providing specifics, the overall picture is quite bleak. The problem of the local people's social-economic condition is made worse by climate change, which is manifested in the reduced moisture content of the soil, which leads to the shrinkage of the vegetation cover and lowers agricultural production. Without immediate action, the fertile layer of the land would erode, decreasing both biological and economic production.</p> <p>The proposed project aims to introduce sustainable methods of water and land management in the Kigezi highlands to better adapt to the effects of climate change. In particular, the initiative will;</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Build capacity for the rational management of surface and groundwater resources for the agricultural and domestic needs with due regard to the climate changes within the project site The transition from unsustainable farming practices to more economically and environmentally beneficial practices. Establish min-farms to demonstrate sustainable soil and water management as compared to the farming approaches of the local people. <p>Upon implementation of this project, a demonstration of the benefits will encourage other local people to participate. Besides, the aforementioned project's activities will give locals a different source of income. Growing Napier grass and calliandra and gruveria trees among other activities will increase the mechanical composition and soil fertility. Besides, the local communities will have alternative sources of income, thanks to the operations of the aforementioned initiative. It is hoped that the planned project will protect the local community's ability to manage traditional farming practices in the face of climate change circumstances that may cause severe land degradation. By lessening the burden of unsystematic agricultural techniques and preserving the ecosystem, the project's actions will make it possible to prevent harmful effects while allowing the community to manage sustainable farming.</p>

Title of project: Enhancing participation of smallholder producers in the mainstream agricultural economy: Training to develop key competencies in GLOBAL G.A.P. and ecological agriculture	

Key Action: Learning mobility of 3 professionals

Project background

Commercial markets in the region and globally are currently undergoing rapid evolution where modern retailers and consumers place much emphasis on stringent food safety (free from contaminants including residual agro-chemicals and fertilisers) and quality standards. This development is partially driven by rapidly changing and globalizing food economy and as a result of the concerns and commitments of a wide range of stakeholders regarding food production and security, food safety and quality, and the environmental sustainability of agriculture. To gain access to lucrative markets, smallholder farmers have to produce good quality products that are free from contaminants and thus meet minimum food safety requirements. The inability to meet the required minimum market requirements is one of the major constraints limiting smallholder farmers to access commercial markets locally and beyond. This can only be achieved through implementation of a food safety management systems based on GLOBAL G.A.P. This certification programme is a key milestone in ensuring product safety and quality standards and better remuneration of farmers from their production investments. GLOBAL G.A.P. comprise Good Agricultural Practices (G.A.P.) which are practices that address environmental, economic and social sustainability for on-farm processes, and result in safe and quality food.

The main goal of the mobility project is to capacitate SIRDC fruit and vegetable professionals with much needed competences for the implementation of GLOBAL G.A.P. Certification Programme. This will enable trained staff to develop and launch a G.A.P. implementation program at SIRDC which will see farmers (both smallholder and commercial farmers) being trained to implement sanitary and phytosanitary measures from production, harvesting to post-harvest handling. Through continuous training and farm audits farmers will be enabled to produce good quality products that comply with food safety and quality standards as required by the market. Thus will increase their access to commercial markets (locally and abroad) for higher investment returns. Moreover, the certification programme will also ensure safety and health to consumers.

Project Objectives:

1. Increase capacities (knowledge, practical skills and professional competencies) of SIRDC technical professionals (fruit and vegetable crops) through theoretical and practical on-farm training qualifying them to be GLOBAL G.A.P. Farm Assurers.
2. Enable participants to provide services related to Good Agricultural Practices and especially GLOBAL G.A.P. to stakeholders including small scale farmers
3. Launch of GLOBAL G.A.P. development (training) program at SIRDC

Mobility: Mobility will last between 4 to 6 weeks

Approach: For realization of mobility and the achievement of the identified learning outcomes, the project seeks cooperation, capacity building and exchange of experience in food safety sanitary and phytosanitary standards (GLOBAL G.A.P.) for fruit and vegetable crops. We propose that the practical components of training take place entirely in well-established agricultural farms. **Organic farms** will be an advantage as participants will also harness skills and technology in **ecological farming**

Outcome: Trained participants will be certified Global G.A.P. Farm Assurers, Consultants, Auditors or Inspectors

- The scientists will be trained in Farm Assurer workshops
- Participants will interact with GLOBAL G.A.P. Licensed Farm Assurers in Austria
- Practicals will be conducted on-farm training in Good Agricultural Practices for the participants
- Participants will receive on-farm assessment training modules covering different aspects of the GLOBAL G.A.P. standard such as soil management and fertilization, integrated pest management, and food hygiene training, worker health and safety
- Trained participants will be enabled to develop a GLOBAL G.A.P. implementation program/curricula
- They will be enabled to set up and launch a GLOBAL G.A.P. certification training program at home with several benefits:
 - Facilitate the process of training farmers to meet certification levels
 - Provide technical resources and consultation to growers to aid in their achieving GLOBAL G.A.P.
 - Standards
 - Connect farmers with GLOBAL G.A.P. approved certification bodies
 - Assist farmers with access to markets

There are no institutions in Zimbabwe that offer trainings and sufficiently support farmers to implement GLOBAL G.A.P. The proposed project and its outcomes will be a great milestone for SIRDC (as the Zimbabwe Technology Development Centre) as it will provide on-farm assistance to stakeholders in implementing sanitary and phytosanitary measures in compliance with GLOBAL G.A.P. as Farm Assurers, Consultants, Auditors, or Inspectors.
