ABSTRACTS

Presenters of papers or posters should send an abstract of not more than 300 words in English in Time New Roman Font 12, single spacing. The margins should be 1 inch all sides, to be sent via e-mail to: conference21@kibu.ac.ke. Abstracts should include: Objectives, Methodology, Results and Conclusion. It should also include: Title, author's name, institutional affiliation, e-mail address, phone number, and subtheme. Avoid references in abstract.

The full papers for accepted abstracts should be submitted by 30th April 2021. Full Papers should be between 3,000 and 5,000 words prepared in Times New Romans Font 12, spacing 1.5.

Empirical Papers: Cover page with Title of Paper, Abstract (300 words approx.), Keywords, (max 5), Introduction, Materials and Methods, Results, Discussions Conductor Papers Conference Confer

Discussions, Conclusion, Recommendations, References.

Posters: Height 80 cm, width 60 cm, or A1 paper size References: Use APA style 6th edition, avoid footnotes Appendices/ Annexes: Should follow references
