The full version of your paper should be formatted as per the guidelines given below. The submitted paper should be in between 2000,-5,000 words (not more than 10 pages as per formatting guidelines, including all the text, figures, tables, references, and appendices).

### Paper Format

1. The submitted paper should be in between 2000,-5,000 words
2. The maximum limit for the paper is 10 pages (including text, figures, tables, references, & appendices)
3. Similarity has to be less than 15%
4. The paper required in MS word, A4 size with 1-inch margin on all sides, "Times New Roman", font size 12, line spacing 1.5, headings bold, sub headings italic.
5. All tables, figures, graphs, included in the text with mentions of the source, captions and proper numbering.
6. Proper citation and referencing as per latest APA guidelines.
7. Abstract 150-200 words, with 5-7 keywords, highlight the sub-sections such as purpose design/methodology/approach, findings, research limitations/implications, social implications, and originality/value.
8. The first page of the paper should contain title, author name, affiliation, email ID followed by abstract.

## Publication & Presentation

Selected and presented papers will be published in conference proceeding with ISBN. Best papers selected by panel members will be published with Scopus as agreed with the terms and conditions of the journal. Each author is required to register individually. All registered participants will be issued e-certificate.
